Directions and Parking

Take the road directly across from the zoo (Carnegie Ave) and go north without stopping. The name of the road changes to Centre Line at the County boundary.

Go straight until you reach County Road 7 and turn left. (west). (If you come to Road 8 and the Selwyn Town Hall, you have gone too far.)

Travel on the 7th Line until you go over the creek and then start looking for the sign on the left Millers Creek Conservation Area.

Park on the south side of the road (not in the laneway).

There is a map at the entrance to help you choose your route.

Enjoy your walk. Don't forget to bring a few seeds.
